Coalition – An alliance of entities for combined action.

Group Home - A home where a small number of people in need of care, support, or supervision, such as the elderly, can live together. In this case, a group of children in the foster care system.

Law Enforcement Coalition - An alliance of local law enforcement entities (police departments, county sheriffs, FBI, etc.) for combined action.

Lord's Gym - Lord's Gym, Inc. is a non-profit organization which was formed with the goal of providing a way to reach the young people of the community, to create a safe place for our future leaders. Lord's Gym strives to teach young people how to make right moral choices and say no to what is wrong and yes to what is right. See more at www.lordsgym.org.

Network – An organization that facilitates like-minded groups and individuals recognize, create, or act upon opportunities; in this case, opportunities related to anti-trafficking.

NGO – Non-Governmental Organization that provides services. This is the international lingo for a Non-Profit Organization, since non-profit status is dependent on a particular nation's laws.

Non-Profit – A corporation or an association that conducts business for the benefit of the general public without shareholders and without a profit motive.

Task Force - A unit specially organized for a task. In this case, the task would be related to combatting local sex trafficking.
