



Session 2: A Case for Hope and the Prevention Template

Goals

- To give an example of how preventing trafficking is already being done by the Church through ordinary Christians
- To understand the different types of trafficking prevention and why some plans don't work
- To understand the three fundamental components of sex trafficking and how they work together
- To introduce how you fit into the fight against trafficking in your own community

Leader Preparation

- Complete [Community Mapping Assignment for Session 2](#)
 - It will be up to you to decide whether you will do all of Steps A, B, and C, or only one or two of the steps, but at a minimum, complete Step A before you go. You may work with your group to do the further research in Steps B and C, but it is important to have the first step complete in order to divide up your work.
 - If you are doing this training for a larger group such as an all-church training over a shorter period of time (example 2 full days), we would recommend doing all of the research up front so that you can invite representatives of the organizations you screen to the training event. This provides an opportunity for the organizations to recruit new volunteers immediately after they have completed the training and provides people with tangible opportunities to get involved.
- Ensure that videos are loaded and ready
- Print out handouts and homework for group members

Session Step-By-Step

1. Open in prayer
2. Discuss questions from [Homework: Session 1](#)
 - What I am hesitant about in starting this training?
 - What holds me back from taking what I learn and implementing it practically?
 - Looking at my schedule, how much time do I have to give? Do I need to make adjustments to make it possible for me to actively engage in this issue?
 - *Trafficking is not an issue that is limited to faraway lands – it is happening everywhere and near at hand. Pray for the victims in your area who are being trafficked and that God would give you a spirit of faith to see and believe that transformation can happen. What is God teaching you about having faith for radical transformation?*

- *Read the supplemental materials for this session and look into statistics and definitions for yourself. What were some things that you didn't know before or were surprising to you from your study this week?*
 - *Look up the scriptures that talk about God's heart for justice and restoration and how it applies to the issue of trafficking and your role therein. Share some of the scriptures that you found and what you learned about God's heart for justice.*
2. Pass out the [Session 2 Handout](#) and ask people to follow along during the video.
 3. Watch the Training Video: Session 2
 4. Discuss. The following are sample questions, but feel free to use your own
 - Were there any aspects of the prevention template and the way it works in Svay Pak surprising to you? Why?
 - Do you believe that something similar to the work happening in Svay Pak can happen in your own community or region?
 5. Share what you learned from the [Community Mapping Assignment: Session 2](#)
 - If you did only Step A or Steps A and B, discuss as a group how you want to move forward to complete the research
 - If you completed all of research already, discuss the findings as a group. Remember that you do not need to commit to any group yet as you will be learning about many other organizations in the weeks to come. However, begin to prayerfully consider where God may be calling you as individuals and as a group to get involved.
 6. Tell people about the additional resources available online (see list below)
 7. Pass out the [homework](#) and tell people you will be discussing the questions next session
 8. Close in prayer
