



Session 5: Confronting Demand Part 2 – In the Church and in Our Hearts

Goals

- To understand that the role of the Church is for transformation while the role of government is for shame and punishment
- To learn how pornography relates to sex trafficking
- To gain the tools and resources to fight for purity in the Church and in our own hearts

Leader Preparation

- Complete [Community Mapping Assignment for Session 5](#), Step A
 - Record your findings to share with the group.
 - If you are doing this training for a larger group such as an all-church training over a shorter period of time (example 2 full days), you can complete Steps A and B so that you can share the outcome of your meetings with your church or larger group. You can also invite representatives from any groups or ministries you identify to attend the training to provide people with immediate opportunities to get involved in accountability, support, etc.
- Ensure that video is loaded and ready
- Print out homework for group members to take home and review by next session

Session Step-By-Step

1. Open in prayer
2. Discuss what you learned last week from [Homework: Session 4](#)
 - What did you learn from the supplemental writings that was new, surprising, disturbing, or interesting?
 - What did you learn about any pending laws or legislation in your own communities and how might you as a group get involved?
3. If the group completed Steps B and C from the [Community Mapping Assignment: Session 4](#), discuss your findings.
4. Pass out the [Session 5 Handout](#) and ask people to follow along during the video.
5. Watch the Training Video: Session 5
6. Discuss. The following are sample questions, but feel free to use your own
 - How does the role of the Church compare with the role of government in confronting demand?

- What does this mean for how the Church should address people struggling with pornography addiction or temptation?
- 7. Share what you learned from the [Community Mapping Assignment: Session 5](#)
 - Are there available resources or a need for resources in your community? What are the gaps in resources that are available?
 - Discuss as a group how you want to proceed with Step B. Regardless of whether the group wants to actively participate in this aspect of the fight against trafficking, you should complete this step. Remember, you don't have to commit to any of the ministries at this time unless you feel called, but be in prayerful consideration about how you will get involved in the future.
- 8. Tell people about the additional resources available online (see list below)
- 9. Pass out the [homework](#) and tell people you will be discussing the questions next session
- 10. Close in prayer
